Last Wednesday evening we were really pleased to host the first School Association meeting since March. This was the Annual General Meeting, as well as a General Meeting afterwards. As Public Health restrictions limit the number of adults we can have on site with physical distancing restrictions, we only had a small group of members attending, but it was great to have adults participating at school with us.

We farewelled and thanked members of the committee, including Jayne, Rosie and Kym. We really appreciate their commitment to supporting our school students and the community and I am sure that their support will continue in other ways. We also welcomed new committee members Chris and Kisha. We are appreciative of the parents and community members who nominated for the committee. Parents and community members who are interested in being involved and supporting our vision are very welcome to be involved – perhaps this can be through our sub committees. The Tasmanian Government has commenced a review on the governance framework for the three statutory entities that regulate education in Tasmania - the Office of the Education Registrar, the Office of Tasmanian Assessment, Standards and Certification, and the Teachers Registration Board.



These entities provide critical education regulatory oversight and support services.

What they do impacts:

- the quality of the teaching that learners experience
- how learning is assessed and recognised
- the quality and safety of our learning environments
- the extent to which students are participating and engaged in learning pathways that are right for them.

A Steering Committee, including representatives from all three education sectors (government, catholic and independent) has been set up to guide the Review.

They are seeking community input into the review through the release of a Discussion Paper. Your feedback is invaluable to ensuring broad community views are captured and reflected in a future governance framework for education in Tasmania.

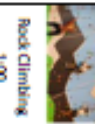
