FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Hello everyone,

Preparing for 2021

Next year our school will undergo a change in class structures based on the significant number of students who will be leaving from grade 6. Schools are funded by the DoE on student numbers and an equity formula – referred to as the Fairer Funding Model. We are given a staffing allocation based on this. When our numbers are less we receive less staffing, and less funding in the school resource package. The number of students that are leaving grade 6 means that next year we will need to reduce our class numbers. The leadership team give a significant amount of thought and planning to the structures for each year and involve the teaching staff in decision making opportunities. It is well planned and strategic – always the best that we can do with the resourcing we have. The current structures for 2021 include a very significant monetary allocation of the resource package provided to the school for the year in extra teacher staffing. Additional to this is the funding that we contribute to the allocation of teacher assistants, which equates to approximately half of our funding. The remainder of the funding is required to support all areas of our school.

The class structures for 2021 will be:

- 3 Kindergartens
- 2 Preps
- 3 Grade 1/2s
- 1 Grade 2/3
- 2 Grade 3/4s
- 1 Grade 4/5
- 3 Grade 5/6s

These structures provide us with opportunities to support parent requests, friendship requests, and equity in the class numbers. In the next few weeks we will share the teachers, as well as students in each class. If you are aware that your child will NOT be attending Hagley in 2021 please let the Office know as soon as possible.

As we head towards the end of the school year there is much to be celebrating at Hagley Farm School. Yesterday our whole school watched our Kinder and Prep students perform in their dress rehearsal for their end of year performance on Thursday. This was great practise – with all of our students focussed, participating and enjoying themselves. It was clear how much time and effort that teachers have given to this preparation. Thursday will be very special, when parents and family members are able to watch the performance online.

Next week we will also have the opportunity to do the same for the grade 5/6 production. Teachers and students have been working throughout this term in preparation, and around 100 students will have a role in making the production a success. I am really looking forward to this, as I am sure our families are too. We will watch their dress rehearsal on Wednesday morning next week, and then go live online soon after this.

Last week our School Association Committee met for the last meeting of the year. One of our major actions was reviewing and accepting the recommendations of the committee working party for our School Uniform. The recommendations that were passed for the Uniform policy are:

- Navy socks are now required as part of the Everyday Uniform (phasing navy socks in through 2021. White socks are still acceptable in 2021)
- The sports uniform will no longer require polo tops in house colours. Instead, primary students can wear a t-shirt of their house colour for carnivals such as cross country and athletics. Early childhood students will wear the Hagley School polo top from the everyday uniform. The royal blue sports top has been removed from the policy. House colours are not to be worn on PE days.

The Uniform Policy will soon be available on our school website.

NEWS FROM THE LIBRARY

During our Learning at Home time, we know that some of the books from classrooms have ended up at home, so if you find a library book but it's not on your child's list of books, please still return it.

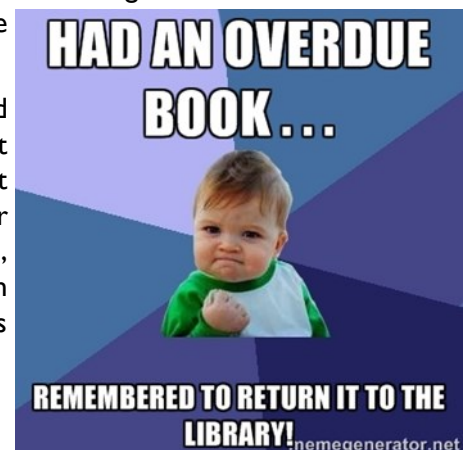
Our library books have a barcode sticker on the back, top right-hand side in most cases, and are stamped as Hagley Library books on the first few pages of the book.

That said, we do gratefully accept donations towards the cost of a new copy if families can afford to do so. Invoices will only be sent if we do not hear back from families about missing or damaged books.

Enjoy those book hunting moments!

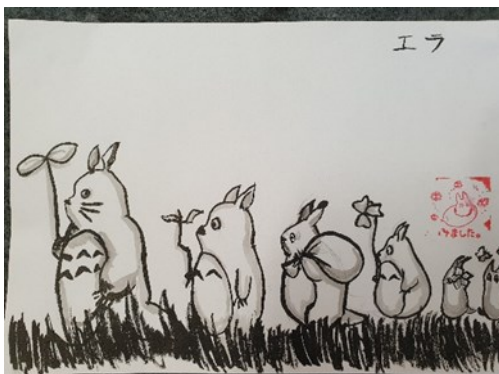
