FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Hello everyone,

What a busy two weeks we have ahead of us. This Wednesday our Grade 5/6s will share their 2020 performance with us – as a dress rehearsal for the whole school in the morning, and then online for our parent community at 11.15am. This has been a long and very different process for us this year - knowing that it was most likely that we would not be able to have an audience. The classes designed their performance, with this in mind. The students, the Grade 5/6 teachers and Mrs Partridge have worked very hard for weeks. We are excited to see the culmination of their commitment and determination tomorrow. We really hope that families enjoy the performance in a different way, appreciate the incredible work that has gone into it, and understand the need for the online audience.

On Thursday afternoon the end of 2020 Reports will be sent home with students. These reports have had many hours of time, thought, consideration and writing given by teachers in preparing them for parents. We hope that you appreciate the effort that has been given to preparing them for you. The report is a document for parents about your child's performance and participation at school – and we encourage you to discuss this with your child. To ensure that the report comes home to you unopened and ready for you to share together, we would like you to discuss the importance of this with them before Thursday. Teachers will work with students to encourage them to wait until they are home with you to read the assessments and comments as well. Please encourage your child to do this. In the past we have had many students open and read their reports on their bus – and some reports not arrive home at all.

On Friday we will hold our Grade 3 – 5 Presentation Assembly – which will be live streamed for our community. The Early Childhood Assembly will be held on Tuesday 15th at 10am. These presentations are a celebration of the academic, social, cultural and values based participation of our students and their contribution to our school. We look forward to celebrating these achievements with you.

Next Monday students will meet their 2021 classmates and, in most cases, their new teachers. On Monday afternoon they will bring home a document with their new class information for you. There will also be information regarding 2021 levies. In next week's newsletter we will formally announce the teachers for each class to the whole community.

Next week our Grade 6s will be involved in a number of special activities, as they reach the end of their time at Hagley Farm Primary School. For all official day time events we require them to be in full school uniform. The new style of Leavers T-shirt means that this is an acceptable part of their uniform for the day. The Grade 6 Presentation Assembly will be held on Tuesday 15th December at 1.30pm. Please remember that only one member of the family can attend this celebration – while others can join online.

The Leavers' Dinner is being held on Wednesday evening next week. To be mindful and considerate of everyone's safety it is essential that the restrictions for viewers are upheld. This is a really special event for everyone, and we ask that everybody's comfort and safety is considered during the arrivals. Please follow our requests for limited numbers of adults and not staying after your own child has arrived. Our staff will take photos of individuals and friends together – as well as the whole cohort of 65 together – which we are happy to share with you. Again, we understand that this is a challenge for families, but we believe that it is a necessary part of our Covid 19 safety planning, and essential to us under the Public Health restrictions.

NEWS FROM THE LIBRARY

During our Learning at Home time, we know that some of the books from classrooms have ended up at home, so if you find a library book but it's not on your child's list of books, please still return it.

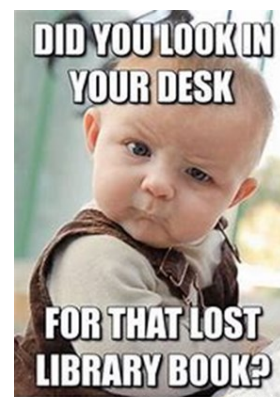
Our library books have a barcode sticker on the back, top right-hand side in most cases, and are stamped as Hagley Library books on the first few pages of the book.

Missing/Damaged Books – If your child has a book out and you cannot find it, or it is damaged, please let us know. If it is lost, we will search for it at school. We *do not* invoice families for lost or damaged books if they are able to let us know what the situation is. That said, we do gratefully accept donations towards the cost of a new copy if families can afford to do so. Invoices will only be sent if we do not hear back from families about missing or damaged books.
