FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK

Hello everyone,

We have enjoyed a fantastic start to the year. Classes are settled, and the playground is busy with games and new friendships growing. I have visited every classroom and spent time in the playground, and I am very proud of the positive way that we have begun the year. The school Values of Respect, Courage, Aspiration and Growth are already being highlighted by individuals, groups and classes with goal setting for learning and play as a focus. I am really looking forward to the term ahead – working positively with our teachers, staff and families to create great outcomes for our students.

This year we have several students in our school and in the main playground who have critical allergies and therefore our school and community need to respond proactively to ensure their safety. We are identifying as a 'Nut Aware School', which is usual practice for Tasmanian Department of Education Schools. This means that we request and encourage all families be aware of the dangers of nuts being in our school grounds, and do not provide them in your child's lunch box.

Peanut allergies constitute the most prevalent high risk allergy in children and adults and therefore requires the most stringent avoidance within the school setting. Reactions are often more severe than other food allergies, and we know that the specific students with allergies have life threatening responses to NUT PRODUCTS. VERY MINUTE QUANTITIES OF NUTS CAN TRIGGER A LIFE THREATENING REACTION.

Please support our 'NUT AWARENESS APPROACH' to student and adult safety in our school by not putting nut products in your child's lunch box. This includes a wide range of products as well as plain nuts.

Imagine if this was your child with such a severe allergy. Please pack your child's lunch with care and concern for the other members of our school. I thank you for your support.


