Our next steps are to review the placements we have made and make necessary adjustments. This will be an ongoing process for a week or two and then placements will be formalised.

Unfortunately, if you have not provided a request it is now too late to do so. We are not able to accommodate any new information, as this will likely compromise all of the work that has already been done.

Today was our annual Swimming Carnival. Sadly we have had to maintain no spectators at the event, due to physical restrictions and physical density. There were many close events, where our students called on the school values of Courage, Aspiration and Growth to give a bit more in their races and give it everything they had. Last Friday our students did not attend school, however, our teachers and school support staff participated in professional learning during the student free day. We also spent time looking at Staff survey data and Student Wellbeing data which will inform our school improvement journey over the next few years. Professional learning days are highly valued, and we thank you for the opportunity to be able to participate in them in the way that we do. It is a valuable time that we use very well to support our ongoing knowledge and understanding in education.

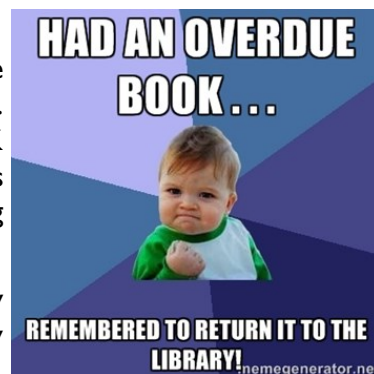


## NEWS FROM THE LIBRARY
