**FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK**

Hello everyone,

During the School Association Committee meeting last week a motion was placed and approved to begin a process to change the name of the Visitor Centre to something that better describes the work that we do. Visitor Centre just doesn't do that. We used to be called the Environment Centre – and we don't think that describes our work either.

The Hagley Farm School Visitor Centre is a part of the Department of Education collective of Field Study Centres. This comprises Hagley Farm School Visitor Centre, the Molesworth Environment Centre, the Sustainability Learning Centre, Mount Cameron Field Study Centre, and the Woodbridge Marine Discovery Centre. The Hagley Farm School Visitor Centre incorporates our working farm to create a genuine Field Study Centre. Our students, but also more than 5000 others engage with hands-on experiential learning in agricultural-based activities, provided by two experienced teachers. It attracts learners from across the State, coming for day experiences as well as opportunities to stay for camps, overnight or longer. Learners can be of a preschool age and extend through to adulthood. We have ongoing partnerships with outside agencies such as TasTAFE, TIA, TFGA and TAPG utilising our farm for training and education. The school age learning opportunities focus on heritage, animal awareness and farm environment, but the experiences that are provided under these headings have grown and developed incredibly in complexity over recent years. The learning experiences for older primary aged students are extensively modified. We are rapidly developing opportunities for secondary school students. The experiences that our Visitor Centre provide are opportunities that promote interest in our young people to consider a career in agriculture.

So we are looking for community suggestions for our new name, and we would like you to see what we do, if you haven't already seen the Field Study Centre resources. Next Friday afternoon, the 26<sup>th</sup> November, we are opening the Farm Circle for our community to come to see what we do, so we'd love you to come along, have a chat, enjoy a sausage while having a look around with some of our staff. The Field Study Centre will be open between 4.30pm and 6.30pm.
