From the Principal

Hello everyone,

We have just rolled into the last half of term 2. Winter is here and the weather is certainly becoming colder. I am really proud of the way that our students are continuing to wear their uniform respectfully while the weather is changing. I encourage this to continue as the weather gets School beanies are making an appearance – which is wonderful! As you know, puffer jackets are not a part of our uniform, despite our cold morning frosts, and are discouraged from being worn, even blue ones. Anyone who arrives in a puffer will need to take it off once at school and will not be able to wear it in classrooms or the school grounds. We encourage school uniform that includes layers for warmth, with our school jacket over the top. We are currently exploring a winter coat as an option for students, but this has not been decided on as yet.

Teachers have been working exceptionally hard during this term to finalise evidences of learning for your children as they prepare for mid year assessments, and very importantly parent teacher student discussions about learning and participation and engagement.

Did you know that one of the most impactful influences on student learning is the partnership that school and families have together - so that students understand the importance and the value of their learning? Your partnership with us is critically important, and I encourage every family to make a time to meet with teachers over the next several weeks. Please include your child in the discussions, so that we can work together to make learning more accessible for them, to prioritise learning goals and to ensure that we are working together to see them at school, every day and engaged. We want all of our families to be engaged in these conversations. Parent, teacher and student learning conversations are critically important. We have many families who are already booked in to meet with teachers - but we need everyone to be a part of these discussions. If you have not already done so, please book an appointment with your child's teacher, and please bring your child to join the discussion. Their learning, participation and engagement is the purpose of the discussion, so they should be a part of it, whatever their age.

MID-YEAR REPORTS

Kindergarten Developmental Checks (KDC) for Kinder students have been distributed on Monday, 2nd June.

Mid-year reports for students in **Years 1–6** will be available for collection during the **Parent/Teacher/Student Discussions in Weeks 7 and 8**.

Students in **Years 1–6** will receive a **9-point visual scale (A–E)** rating to indicate their achievement against the expected standard for their year level against the curriculum areas of English, Mathematics and Science. Prep students will receive this scale **only at the end of the year**.

As there is **no written report for Prep students at mid-year**, we strongly encourage you to attend the **Parent/Teacher/Student Conferences in Weeks 7 and 8**. A written report for Prep students will be issued in **Term 4**.

Please note: There will be no teacher comments included in the reports. The conferences are a valuable opportunity to discuss your child's progress, learning, and behaviour in detail. We highly encourage all families to attend.

Details on how to book your Parent/Teacher/Student Conference are provided below.

Parent/Teacher/Student conferences for the Kinder - Grade 6 classes will begin in week 7 of this term, commencing Tuesday 10th of June (Kinder only) and finishing Wednesday the 18th of June. Please note that our Kinder classes will have some different days.

The booking system opened on Wednesday, 28th May at 9:00 AM.

The sessions will be on:Tuesday 10th 3:15pm-4:30pm (Kinder only). Wednesday 11th 9am-12pm (Kinder only). Thursday 12th 3:15pm-7pm; Monday 16th 3:15pm-4pm; Tuesday 17th 3:15pm – 4:30pm; Wednesday 18th 3:15pm-4pm.
