MID-YEAR REPORTS

Kindergarten Developmental Checks (KDC) for Kinder students have been distributed on Monday, 2nd June.

Mid-year reports for students in **Years 1–6** will be available for collection during the **Parent/Teacher/Student Discussions in Weeks 7 and 8**.

Students in Years 1–6 will receive a 9-point visual scale (A–E) rating to indicate their achievement against the expected standard for their year level against the curriculum areas of English, Mathematics and Science. Prep students will receive this scale only at the end of the year.

As there is **no written report for Prep students at mid-year**, we strongly encourage you to attend the **Parent/Teacher/Student Conferences in Weeks 7 and 8**. A written report for Prep students will be issued in **Term 4**.

Please note: There will be no teacher comments included in the reports. The conferences are a valuable opportunity to discuss your child's progress, learning, and behaviour in detail. We highly encourage all families to attend.
