## From the Principal

Hello everyone

It has been wonderful to see such a positive start to Term 3. Students are engaged in their learning, and play is positive, kind and safe. This will help to keep our classrooms clean.

Last week we welcomed Mr Pete Garwood to Hagley in the role of School Chaplain. Pete's focus will be to support us in our goal of building and maintaining connection and belonging to school, to support students who struggle to come to school regularly to turn that around and be at school more often, and to support wellbeing amongst our Primary students. Some families might know of Pete through his earlier time working at Hagley, and also in his Chaplaincy role at Prospect High School. We are looking forward to working with Pete on Tuesdays and Wednesdays for the rest of this year.

To mark mourning and respect for the Honourable Sir Guy Green AC, KBE, CVO, whose funeral was held today, the Australian Flag was flown at halfmast. Sir Guy Green was Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Tasmania from 1973 to 1995, Chancellor of the University of Tasmania from 1985 to 1995, and the State's first Tasmanian-born Governor from 1995 to 2003. As Chief Justice, he modernised judicial processes while upholding the integrity of the law. As Governor, he will be remembered for his devotion to the people of Tasmania. He received numerous honours in recognition of his exceptional service, including Knight Commander of the Order of the British Empire in 1982, Companion of the Order of Australia in 1994 and Commander of the Royal Victorian Order in 2000.
