Hello everyone

At the end of our reporting cycle last year, we asked for feedback about our process and opportunities. From this feedback, and as a part of our Reporting and Communicating to Parent Responsibilities for 2025, we have decided to make some changes. This term, in week 9, we will host an Open Classroom afternoon/early evening, with a barbecue for families. This will involve class teachers being available to welcome parents and carers to view your child's evidence of learning for the and informally discuss learning achievements with your child, and also briefly chat with the teacher. There will also be opportunities for parents to request or to be invited by teachers to join them, either by phone or in person, on the Thursday of that week, to discuss anything that is of concern since last meeting at the end of Term 2.

Of course, we encourage all parents and carers, as well as our teaching staff, to make contact to discuss anything that is of concern during the term - including attendance, learning focus, changes in behaviour, and information we need to know to support your child at school. Our teachers will always welcome conversations with you that will support learning and engagement.

Of course, we will seek feedback from the school community after this event so that we can determine the effectiveness of these changes.






