From the Principal

We are really looking forward to hosting our new Communicating to Families activity this afternoon – our Open Classrooms. To date we have 140 parents booked in to classes, to come along and share evidence of learning together, and to have an opportunity for a short conversation with your child's teacher. We will also be providing the opportunity to enjoy a sausage in bread on the way in or out. The barbecue will be found near the Canteen.

We hope that this is a successful new opportunity for a more informal sharing of learning together, after three-way conversations at the end of term 2.

There is also opportunity on Thursday afternoon for parents to have a more confidential or private conversation with teachers, should you prefer. Some teachers may have reached out already or may give parents a call on Thursday afternoon.

Currently our Grade 3, 4 and 5 students are participating in two weeks of Swimming and Water Saving lessons with Mr Lynch and a team of water safety teachers from DECYP. This is a compulsory part of the curriculum for these grades, and some grade 6 students are invited to be a part of it as well, to ensure that they are able to reach the benchmarks for water safety.

We are lucky that our students get to participate here in our own pool. Thanks to Mr Lynch for his preparation and Bill Deruyter who maintains our pool, working all sorts of hours to ensure it is ready and at standard for swimming.

Tomorrow, Education Facility Attendants across the State will be engaging in industrial action and therefore will not be on site for a period of 24 hours. This action is to make a statement that their work conditions require investment from DECYP. There will be a skeleton staff at Hagley, however, we will find that our rooms and facilities will not be maintained to the standard that they should be during the action.
