From the Principal

This week is an exciting one for our Grade 3/4 classes as they experience their first overnight camp at Hagley Farm School. Yesterday and today Mrs Chatterton/Eyles and Mrs McNear's classes spent the day on the farm with Ms Bunker, Mr Tyson, Mr Fox and Farmer John. They had fun after school exploring their cabins, having a very yummy dinner and a swim before bed. On Thursday and Friday Mr Mason's and Mrs Cini's classes will do the same. This is a terrific experience for our young people, giving them a 'taste' of what a bigger camp in Grade 5/6 will be like, and staying away from home. For some of our students this is the first time they are doing this. Thanks to the ALC staff as well as all of the teachers involved in making camp happen for our students. I am immensely grateful to our teachers, as well as Mrs Beams and Mr Ankin, who have all left their own families at home, some with young children, to provide these experiences. This is an incredibly generous gift of their time.

You may have become aware through the media that the Australian Education Union, along with other state service unions have implemented a planned industrial action for their members. Further information will come to the community as we receive it from DECYP.

As mentioned in the newsletter last week, we will be beginning the process of developing classes for next year in coming weeks. To support this process, we ask that you consider sharing important information with us that will guide our decision making. We place significant focus on teacher input in this process, as well as taking student requests for friendships, and parent requests into account. This process takes us a number of weeks to work through, and we always have the best interests for teaching and learning for every student at the centre of our decisions.

Any information that you send to us is confidential. We will do what we can to support your request, but it may not always be possible. Where we can, we will reach out to families to discuss complicated issues.

If you would like to make a class placement request, you will need to contact the School Office, either by email, or by phoning, and they will provide you with an online link to submit your information. All information **MUST** be submitted using this link.
